Pray for a spirit of acceptance and cooperation between migrants, workers, and local people. That empathy would abound particularly in light of recent developments in Afghanistan. Pray that the host country would look favorably and with understanding on new Afghans arriving. Pray that families would have their needs met and not go hungry or be without shelter and communication. And always, pray that the Promise of Peace would penetrate hearts of the weary.

Our team. We are together! (Well 2/3 of us). We are currently at our pre-field training in Atlanta. It's been a wild few days! Thankyou for those who have been praying for this even for the past several months. As we are together for the entire month of October and into November, would you pray for a few specific things? First, health. Covid is still a reality for us that we want to navigate respectfully and wisely. Pray that we will know when to take appropriate risk and when to step back. So much spirit leading! Which actually leads into our next request. In our training house there are 9 adults and 9 children. It can get a little wild sometimes! Pray that we, adults and children, have wisdom how to share life together, set boundaries, form team, initiate and resolve conflict, speak into each other's children's lives, etc. Pray that we can become a HEALTHY family. The Lord has already shown so much kindness to our team in the past few days. Pray that we wouldn't hesitate to continue deepening our relationship.

Our family. Friends, our mental health is so good right now (that's a huge praise!) We have been immensely uplifted by the close relationships we are experiencing in the house. Pray that our physical bodies would not give out on us. Between John's migraines, my celiac, and Reagan's anxiety we are bound to have a few hiccups along the way.

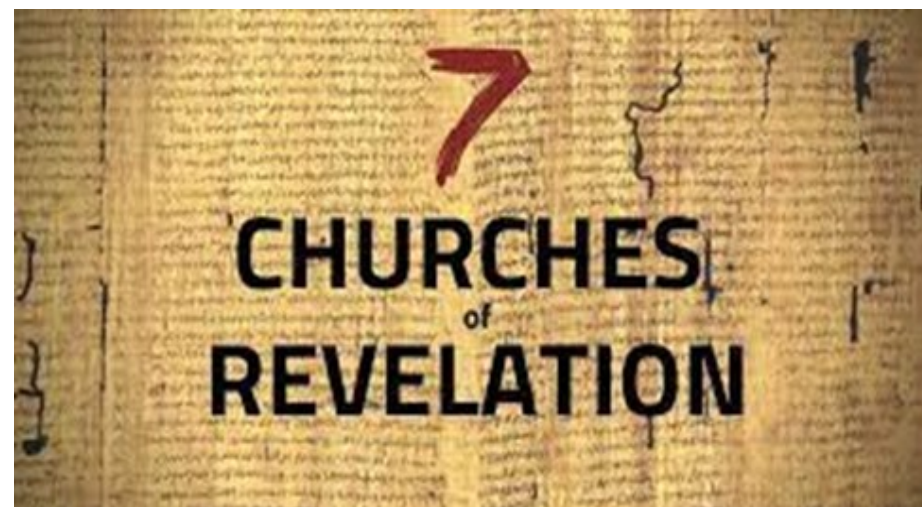

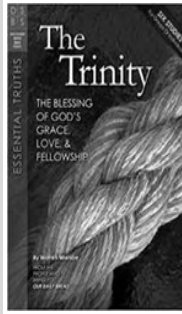
