The conversations are turning to visas, apartments, cellphones, and language schools. As we begin the serious talks of transition, would you be in prayer for some specific things for us in country? **Pray** for our housing: The market is difficult right now and finding an apartment is difficult and expensive. We ask for guidance from the Spirit. **Pray** that we would meet people who can support us in this transition: this includes language helpers, friends for our kids, nice old ladies at the bus stop who give us directions, etc. **Pray** for the kids schooling options: once in country, we need to make decisions about whether public school (our first choice) will be the best option for them considering covid has closed the schools often.

Be in **prayer** for our team. Thank you for all the prayers during our pre-field training for team unity! It was a remarkable time for our state-side teammates to bond. We are so excited to be on the field together! Please continue to **pray** that the last few months together in the states will be fruitful and our hearts will grow closer. **Pray** also for our teammates in country as they prepare to receive us. Helping a family move to a new country is no easy task and they will need lots of stamina to help us!

Be in **prayer** for our family. Being on the other side of our pre-field training is a huge step for our family! Thank you for your prayers that sustained us during our time in training. Words are not enough to describe the impact your faithfulness in prayer had on our time. Thank you, thank you. We have jumped right into our language training and are hoping to complete it by the new year. **Pray** that we are able to have focus several hours a day to complete all of the assignments. The kids are now being home schooled and would very much appreciate your thoughts and prayers.

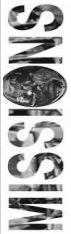

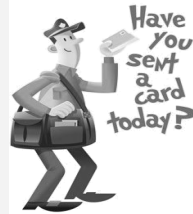
