Karen Foster in Cameroon

On January 29 we expect to give 33 diplomas and wives certificates to the second class of our Cameroon Bible Institute. That's 15 couples, 2 single men and 1 wife of a pastor from the first class who came back to study as a student (after the much simpler wives' program). Classes have ended and preparations are underway for celebrations and returns to home towns.

Pray for all to go smoothly and for these folks to get through it without going into debt or being ashamed because they can't pay for all they'd like to. Relatives have come from out of town as early as 3 weeks before graduation and are staying with the student families. The school is paying return transportation for student families from other towns and their possessions.

Pray for the 2 ladies who will have actual Bible institute diplomas: Naomi and Catherine. How will God use these two who are so far ahead of the other ladies in their churches in terms of bible knowledge? Thank the Lord for the 4 student wives who learned to read while at the Bible Institute. Thank the Lord for the 2 ladies who had their first babies while at school, after many years of waiting: student wife Nadege and teacher Nathelie. Nadege didn't even want to come to school but has no regrets. She's not a reader yet but has picked up a lot of Bible truth.

Some updates from last year's prayer requests:

New believer Al is struggling with a long standing drinking problem. Zena gladly listened to the Bible story with her sister Mari. Maneuvering in Yaounde hasn't been too bad during the soccer tournament, so far. The Cameroon team is doing quite well. Karen has finished another year of donor supported ministry in the black. One more year to go!
