Even though the Stokes had just arrived and were still settling into their house, they very generously watched the kids, loaned suitcases, and hosted meals so that we could prepare to leave. We miss them so much and mourn the time that we are losing together. Proper exit paperwork for us to leave without a record had to be obtained. The multi-day process showed us clearly that the system is currently shifting and some immigration branches didn't even know the services they offered. The Lord was good and allowed us to receive papers that we needed to exit the country without permanent marks on our record (although our actual departure was quite tense).

As we prepared our house to leave, we felt the irony and pain of spending three months and considerable resources (time and financial) putting together a place that would sit empty. In fact, our final Ikea order arrived a few days before we left. We really were pretty sad about it. Our temporary move to the UK would allow us to only take a suitcase each. But now the things we took so much care to pack and transport from the States, the special gifts that were given since our arrival, the items we carefully chose and worked hard to figure out how to buy...would stay...and we would go. This was especially hard for the kids, who had just uprooted and said "goodbye" to so many anchors in their life. But the day came and we had to leave. And we did. And the Lord carried us through. And your prayers carried us through. The airport was super stressful, as we had never been d*p*rt*d before and had the word stamped across all our tickets. Although, I must say, they give you your own security line and it was the shortest security line I have ever been in.

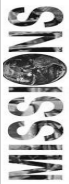
