I learned this week that Trip will be the age to attend middle school in the fall. He will be in a separate school with higher academic expectations. **Pray** for understanding teachers and staff. In elementary school there is a “class mom” who acts as a go-between for teachers and parents. **Pray** that our relationship with this person will be strong and mutually beneficial. **Pray** that we are able to prepare now the gifts and respect that will build strong trust with the important figures in our future.
