“I feel like I live in just enough brokenness to remind me this world is not my home, and just enough grace to remind me that God is good”

I texted to our teammate when I walked into our apartment to find our kitchen flooded. Brokenness and Grace. That has been the theme of our first two months in country. The brokenness of our bodies, sickness, dietary restrictions, language barriers, uprootedness. Grace of God in doctors, rest, solutions to problems, language wins, like minded friends, teammates, babies.

I find it ironic that the “in-between” space I was so anxious to be out of in Atlanta has followed us in new form. But I praise our Father because his Peace has covered us in the perpetual in-between we are now living in (still).

June has been a month of forward movement into uncertainty. John started language classes at the beginning of June, with me (Katelyn) starting a few weeks later. We are already seeing fruit of our study as conversations for necessities are coming more easily. Yesterday I successfully, and with a mutual laugh at my mistakes, bought produce at our weekly outdoor market. Just this morning, John scheduled someone to come make screens for our windows! So impressive if you ask me! We are so thankful for the generous “yava yava” (slowly slowly) attitude from our teachers and neighbors towards our language learning. So much Grace every day.

The kids have also been immersing themselves in the language in different ways. Trip and Raegan have tutors working from both the grammatical and practical side. Raegan had the sweetest mental “click” this week when she finally understood what verb conjugation means! Trip is currently attending his second week of basketball club. The coaches saw potential in him, so they moved him up to the next level this week. It’s wonderful to see him be appreciated and mentored in skills he doesn’t even know he has.
