I can only imagine how exhausted you all must feel with our situation. And our continued ask for funds. Pray for each other that the Lord would hold each of you in this space until you are released.

Be in prayer for our living situation. Would you start praying for our house in country that we will purchase? Pray that the Lord would provide the right house in the right place, at the right price, with the right neighbors. That it would be close to places to study, positive school options for the kids, convenient for public transportation, and would serve our needs now and in the future. Would you pray that we have discernment about whether to have a small house that just fits us or a larger house where we can host others.
