In November 2022, Pastor John Scheller was interviewing for a Pastor of Young Adults position at Kenwood Baptist Church in Cincinnati, Ohio. Several of the church's senior pastoral leadership attended CDF 2022. They shared the videos and their new vision with Pastor John and his wife. Because of the CDF 2022, their church changed directions, recognizing the great need in children's ministry. The job description changed, and Pastor John became the churches Pastor of Children and Family Discipleship.
