## Child Evangelism Fellowship

As we begin a new statistical year, I'll let you know how the summer ended. I left you hanging last month as I didn't have the Miami County Fair results yet and we were in the midst of the Darke County Fair. Miami was rainy and we actually needed jackets sometimes, but 725 heard the Gospel with 80 believing. Sometimes when the atmosphere is not rushed and the tent doesn't seem so crowded, people stay longer and ask questions which lead to a higher percentage of decisions. We can't picture the faces of all 80, but God knows every heart. We serve an awesome God!

After freezing in Miami County, we fried in Darke County. Only crazy people came to the fair. But we were crazy enough to be there to share with 886 of them and were blessed that 145 made decisions. Again, the number hearing the Gospel was down but the number receiving was up. It was so hot that people settled down in front of our 5 fans and didn't want to leave.

Now its time to get the Good News Clubs started. Please be sure your church know they can adopt a school nearby and start an after school GNC. In the meantime, we will have a booth at an Elks event in Greenville and an urban Good News Blitz in Dayton, then return to the Chocolate Festival at the Montgomery County Fairgrounds Event Center. 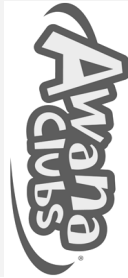
