Our paperwork. We have two big pieces of paperwork that need the Father's mighty work.

The Kid's School Equivalency: In order for Trip and Raegen, our oldest two kids, to be registered with the local school system, we need to apply to the Ministry of Education for approval that they finished their previous grades. This process has been significantly more difficult than we anticipated, mostly because it has been difficult to obtain the right paperwork from the right source state-side. Through the mighty power of the Spirit, He has provided us a fellowship/school that is able to create the document that we need. When I had given hope, He intervened at just the right time. The Lord has been faithful in providing the first piece, but we still do not know how it will be received once the paperwork is submitted to the Ministry of Education. **PRAY** that this document would meet all the requirements and would pass through the checkpoints of approval with ease. Being able to put our kids in local school at this critical time of language and culture development is part of the vision we feel the Lord has given us. He has made it clear that it's only through his power and authority in these places that it will actually come to pass.

Our visa renewal application: It is time for the kids and I (Katelyn) to renew their visas. While this process is technically easier the second time, it still comes with anxiety over what will be. **Pray** that we would be granted favor to stay and endurance to pursue the changing system. One thing that has become very clear to us, is that the immigration system here is designed to be difficult physically, emotionally, and spiritually. **Pray** that we may walk into every office full of Peace from our Father.

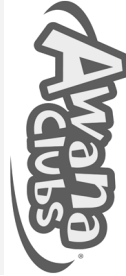
