In September, we held a Training Time for the Study Bible in Yoaunde Cameroon. 50 participants attended the 2-day training time. Among the attendees was the Vice President of the Association of Evangelicals for all of Africa, Dr. Jean Libom, as well as representatives from the Cameroon Bible Society. The two days of training were followed by a morning of celebration and dedication of the Bible. Our prayer is to see the Study Bible help African Christians read more frequently, understand more deeply and live out more fully the truth of God's Word in their daily life.
