We also have big news to share with you... We received all of the funds necessary to purchase our house!!! 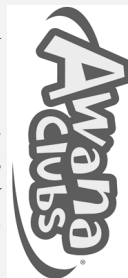

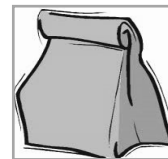
