We are still so new and so much on the outside, that is difficult to know if and how we can help. Pray that likeminded people throughout the country are able to grieve well with their neighbors and friends and that despair would give way to hope in the hearts so many, many people.

Our home and visa. After many long months of waiting, we finally have an appointment to see the house we want to buy. Because of the earthquakes, our ability to tour has been put off several weeks, which may impact our timeline to secure visas. Pray as we go to our appointment Thursday that we would have certainty how to proceed. Pray that this purchase would offer us stability for our lives, school, language learning and future work. We hear stories all over the map about visa acceptance and rejections, but we have certainty that the Lord has led us in this direction, regardless of the outcome.

Our Joy! Last month, a young man from A community was dunked! This week, John and Trip attended another dunking! Still another young man dreamed that he was rescued from the earthquake rubble by the Shepard, sparking some intense conversations. Pray for these young men who have chosen a new path and are searching for answers. The Lord is moving.

Our contacts. We have had some further contact with the families that stayed in our house and would ask that you pray specifically for the Afghan families that stayed in our apartment in August/September.

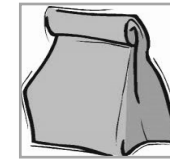
