The sale of our house has still not gone through. There has been a lot of negotiation and extra steps buying post earthquake. The seller has had many special requests and is wanting everything to fall out in his favor. We are so thankful for an incredible team of professionals who are navigating the negotiations on our behalf, but we still watch the days tick down that we can stay. We have committed ourself to God. Would you pray that he moves the barriers, particularly if they are resistance from the enemy.

Pray for our language learning. John and I desperately need language helpers but haven't found success in the avenues we have tries so far. Pray that the Lord would open door to new relationships in our home that are giving and full of learning!

Pray for our kids transition to school. Once we have a house settled, we have the difficult work of transitioning into school. While logistically I don't think it will be too difficult (cooperatively), the environment is going to take its toll on the kids and us. Pray that the Lord will be near. That the kids are able to see tangible gains quickly in their learning and acceptance into the environment.

This week young A. man lost his life attempting a border crossing. Our teammates are helping the family ID the body and make arrangements. Would you keep the family before our Father, that they may see Godly grief and lament in our broken world, but also hope.
