Forgive us for not updating sooner. This week has been so full for us and I am sure our absence has left many of you with concerns. Our family is safe. Our city has not been affected by the disasters in the southeast part of the country. Thank you so much to everyone who reached out asking about our safety. Thank you for every prayers for have lifted up for us and the people of this country. The events are tragic. Even far away as we are, so so many people have lost family and friends. A friend of mine from our Korea days was living in the area of the disaster (they are okay as far as I discern). The cities affected housing many people fleeing conflict and disaster in their own countries of origin. The country is mourning.

And all last week we sat with our team strategizing how to bring living hope. It's ironic, and feels a bit uncomfortable, to be in a position to do so little when there is so much to do. My soul cries "WHY!?" while learning to be content with the pathway before me. It makes me uncomfortable to be living the reality that God is big enough and good enough to hold the suffering of a country while also creating a way for us to buy a house, put our kids in school, learn a language. But it is no different than he has done from the beginning, and does everyday... Hold hope for us in the brokenness while extending Grace to us in the moment.

As we move forward in his grace for the day, would you **pray** that he would continue to provide everything we need. There is a strong potential that the disruptions in daily life could affect several processes we need to take action on for our residency. **Pray** also for our teammates who have been here longer as the asses ways to help.
