

We are finding some new routines and reference points, though will a long way to go. The main area of prayer this month is clarity about our future roles. Several people need to speak into those decisions, so many conversations are involved. Pray that we will



discern God's clear leading regarding our work roles.

Reaching Out: As we continue adapting, God provided an open door for MaryAnn to reach out in discipling students at Cedar-ville College—30 minutes away. Pray that the students will grow, and that MaryAnn will gain insights into US culture. Much has changes since our 1st deployment!

Coaching and Training: As we adapt, Tom is getting trained in how culture affects organizations, as well as behavior awareness in meetings and conversations. We pray these skills will enhance our own ministry and benefit all the various circles where we have influence.
