Thankyou for praying for the Study bible training time held in Benin last month. One of the things I was most impressed by was the strong participation of the Bible societies from countries where Christians are a true minority. A third of the participants came from places where it is indeed a challenge for Christians to live out their faith.

Would you pray for those from the Sahel that participated in our Study Bible training time, that their faith would remain strong and that the Study Bible would be a source of encouragement and spiritual growth in their regions? The other countries represented at the Study Bible training time in Cotonou were: The Central African Republic, Cameroon, Burundi, Benin, Congo Brazzaville, Democratic Republic of Congo, Togo, Ivory Coast, Gabon and Madagascar.

Would you please pray for all of the bible Society representatives who participated in the training time, that they would in turn train others to use the Bible Study? And that many lives will be transformed through their study and application of God's Word?

While in Cotonou, our training and launch team was able to visit the studio of the Christian journalists and radio producers who have completed the recording over 40 radio programs based on the articles found in the study Bible. Raymond and Juliette Monote have done excellent work to make some of the Study Bible content available to oral learners.
