At a recent Awana connect leaders in Central Ohio gathered, discussing todays culture and the need for child discipleship. Paul Gifford, Grace Polaris Awana Ministry Director, shared that they never have time to discuss these topics during their regular Awana ministry. The Awana Connects have been great ways for leaders to "pause" their usual responsibilities and collaborate over discipleship opportunities.

We ask Awana leaders at Awana Connects, "What if we shift our thinking from children's ministry to child discipleship?" Ryan Phipps, Living Hope Church's children's director, Columbus, Ohio, acknowledged this as a paradigm shift and asked, "How are we teaching them, equipping them?"

The research study recently released by Barna and Awana reveals the significant impact a loving, caring adult at church makes on a child's future involvement in church. It is a privilege walking alongside so many people committed to investing in the lives of children in small weekly ways have a tremendous lasting impact.
