We are so grateful for your encouragement, prayers and partnership in the Gospel work of bringing the Scriptures to the people of Vanuatu, specifically on our island of Moto Lava.

We have been in the USA for nearly 6 months now and have felt so much love from all the churches, families and individuals we have visited in our travels. It is wonderful to reconnect after being overseas for 6 years! We have seen God's hand of care and provision in every step and detail along the way, most recently in regards to our son's visa status that was recently granted an extension. We thank you warmly for your prayers and generous, kind hospitality to our family during this time of home assignment. Praise God!

Thank you for praying for Jamie's health! We praise God for His care for Jamie and the mostly positive test results. Jamie had an endoscopic/colonoscopy procedure in Kauai coordinated by friends in the medical field, and her stomach came back positive for a parasite and celiac disease, but negative for cancer. The scope revealed a great deal of inflammation and sores in her stomach. After adjusting to a strictly gluten-free diet, Jamie feels her stomach has improved significantly. We will continue to routinely evaluate Jamie's stomach and abdomen, but for now she is feeling normal. Another test—a diagnostic mammogram—came back mostly normal, but Jamie needs to have a precautionary follow up procedure, for which she will have to travel back to the USA.

Before we can return to Vanuatu and begin resuming work on our Island, we wanted to share with you our current needs and requirements that Wycliffe has worked with us to set: During the past 6 years away, standard cost of living has increased, and Wycliffe has modified our target monthly budget accordingly. We praise God because during much of the time we were away, we were at 100% of our budget. Thank you for your faithful partnership!
