God knew exactly what we needed, and he provided.

Our dear missionary friends in Santo—Chris and Yelena Isaac—had an idea we might need help. The Isaacs have been overseeing an exceptional group of young interns-mostly Slavic Americans, plus one German and one Romanian-who were eager to volunteer. They divided their group into two parts-Chris with the young men, and Yelena with the young women.

I (Aaron) flew up to Mota Lava with Chris and the young men to begin work on the house. The young men spent one week removing the old shelves/cabinets and replacing them with PVC board (which termites wont spoil). There was a young electrician in the group who was able to get our freezer rewired and working again. A few days in, we were joined by Ian Walter of BuildAid Vanuatu, the veteran missionary carpenter who originally built out house. Ian took over the foreman duties and helped us finish out the renovation and install PVC ceiling throughout much of the house.

After a week, Chris an the group of young men flew out Yelena and the group of young woman flew in. Jamie and the kids arrived in this second group. This group worked tirelessly to reclaim the house from the spiders and termites. They also helped us to reorganize everything back into the new shelves/cabinets and hold a yard sale. We were blessed with three extra days with this group because their Friday flight was postponed till Monday. Thanks to this, our family was able to join them on a Saturday hike to the top of a nearby mountain lookout, which we had never done.


Not only is our home livable again, it has been upgraded with a new ceiling, kitchen cabinet doors (baby proofing!), and new wiring and power points in several rooms.
