Jill sliced two of her fingers while clearing her garden with a machete. *Ouch*! We thank God that the accident wasn't worse! Jill needed some proper medicine and time to recover, but she has healed nicely. She's likely to have a couple small scars, but we are glad she's back.

Donalyn's concern is ongoing. She developed a large flesheating tropical boil on her wrist. The DIY island medicine— a poultice (moist leaf compact) - was not drawing out the infection, do we arranged for her and her mom to travel to Santo in order to receive care from the hospital and private clinic there. She has now been in the hospital for a week. Per our update from Donalyn today, the infection has been drained and she is making progress on her recovery. We are praying and hoping for a full recovery, but we understand this may take months. The wound area is very large. Please pray with us for Donalyn. She also is a vital part of drafting our literacy readers that we are developing for the local schools in Motlap.

God foreknew that we would be short-handed for a season and he providentially sent us help!


