Over the last several weeks, we have been short a few handsliterally.

First Waverly broke her wrist. She had attempted a neat trick, leaping from one tree branch to another, but missed. Ouch! The family traveled the next day to Port Vila (this was already scheduled travel), and tried to get Waverly sufficiently cared for there. However, it took Waverly (and her Dad) extra travel from Port Vila to Honolulu to properly reset the bone. Waverly is doing very well (Yay!), but she has spent several weeks attempting to do everyday activities with her non-dominant hand.

Back in Mota Lava, our two most reliable helpers are Jill nd Donalyn. They are part of Aaron's adoptive family in our village. They help in a variety of ways-especially with Vigo-and at times with translation and language learning too. Within the adoptive family, Jill is Aaron's sister. This makes her Vigo's "titamas" (literally small mom in Motlap), and according to traditional custom this is a close bond. So Jill often looks after Vigo and speaks to him in Motlap and Bislama.

Certainly, Jill and Donalyn have been God's provision. Their helping hands, along with a few other unsung heroes, have been vital to our ability to transcend "survival mode" on Mota Lava.


However, their helping hands have been temporarily out on medical leave.
