Our Father is bringing healing and restoration where there was brokenness. He is bringing peace and hope to places long held in fear. The Spirit is moving to draw people to himself. He is moving mountains of paperwork, and mountains of access, and mountains of the heart. From a season of darkness, we see glimmers of light.

You all have been praying for "S", John's language helper. A few weeks ago, John took the opportunity to visit S in the city. Their time together solidifies their relationship into more than a tutoring and reading relationship. As they continue to read the book through the month of fasting, S has been challenging the Why. He continues to think deeply and share with is family how new discoveries, although he is not yet verbalized a change.

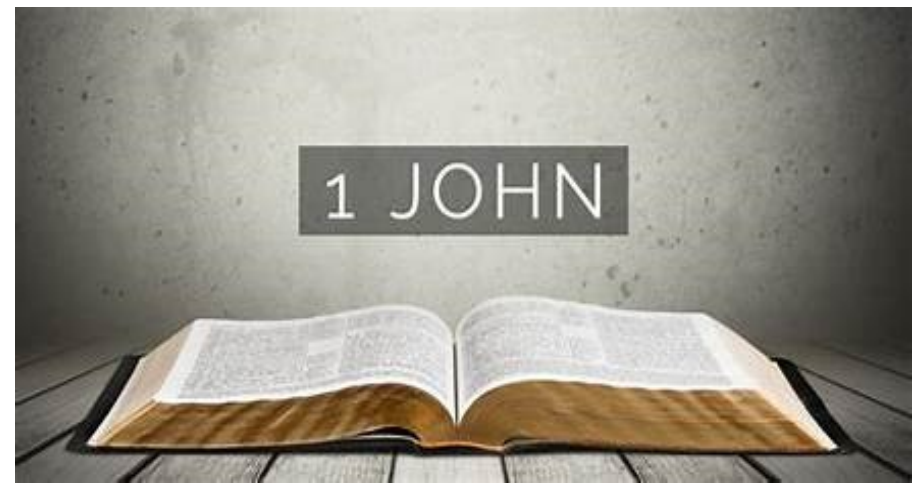
