This school year is just starting for us over here and we are pumped! This fall we have a great opportunity for you to join us in the work that the Lord is doing. Join our Fall Prayer Team!

A full year of being settled in country has given us a much better idea of what we need prayer for this year. We are looking for 30 friends and fellowships to join us in praying regularly for the six categories of needs we have: school, language learning, health, visa& safety, long term vision, and success.

Prayers for the wee[a]k:

1. Monday is the beginning. The beginning of school for the year. As we all (and the kids specifically) begin the long journey of the school year, would you **pray** that we would be encouraged by the Lord's presence at the beginning AND at the end. **Pray** that his presence would strengthen us. Rory's verse for school this year is Romans 8:39 "Nothing in all creation can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus". **Pray** that this would hold true in our hearts and that the Lord would not give us more difficulty than we can handle.

2. John and S have entered Holy Week in their weekly reading. "We are getting close to the crucifixion, aren't we?" S asked. "I'm sad because I like Jesus and I don't want to see people I like suffer." As their reading takes them closer to the death and resurrection of the Son, would you pray that S's sensitivity towards the weight of the work of the cross would increase. **Pray** that he would see his role in both the death and resurrection. May his heart be turned to see God as the Beginning AND the End who now lives and will never die because he conquered death.

3. Friends, many of you prayed for my health, and I have had several messages asking how it is going. I have stabilized and have my energy back, but I am extremely limited in what I can eat. My overwhelming emotion is grief that my list of available foods continues to shrink. I am practicing contentment, and I am content, that whether or not the Lord decides to give me some foods back, he is still Good.
