Greetings in the middle of all of the upheaval. How are you doing? We **pray** you are being protected and used by our Lord to bless people. Joan and I are doing fine, being protected, and continuing to have open doors for ministry. Thank you so much for your prayer for us!

I had an outreach Bible study scheduled for this afternoon, but with all of the chaos, I assume it would be cancelled. I called our disciple and the Bible study host, Keeko Sumita to confirm the cancellation. She said, "Oh no! Everyone still wants to come (6-7 people)." And 3 of these are not yet saved! God continues to work in their hearts to want to study the Bible, even in the midst of citywide cancellations of most other events. Praise His name! We'll be doing a study on "Why there is trouble in the world." Please **pray** especially for Kumagai San, and Watanabe San, that God would open their hearts to put their trust in Him.

Just to put your hearts at rest, Joan and I continue to do our due diligence to reduce the risk of either contacting illness or possibly spreading it. I think we've washed our hands, taken our body temperature, sanitized every surface, and kept a social distance more in the past month than in the past several years combined. We continue to pray for you, and especially those hardest hit by the virus. May our Lord show His mercy and glory, especially in these difficult times.

This morning I read Psalm 145 and was encouraged by the words of the Lord: "I will extol thee, my God, O king; and I will bless thy name for ever and ever.
