Since then, E & S have had opportunities to minister to his family as they all grieve Misha's death, and they have even been able to talk with them about God, Heaven, and His plan for redemption. Pray that these seeds bear fruit. Pray that God's light will spread in Central Asia.

Certain areas in Southeast Asia have been able to mitigate COVID-19's effects, and businesses are reopening. Pray for our global staff as they return to their routines and in-person interaction with their friends and neighbors. Pray that God would fill our Southeast Asia-based staff with wisdom as they work to impact their communities for Christ.

In southwestern Chad, our medical partners provide treatment in a region with few healthcare options. For over a decade, these partners have helped countless patients while sharing Christ. This work has also provided income for church planters in other regions of the country. Pray for this center to continue providing quality healthcare for Chadians. Pray for them to effectively share the love of Christ through word and deed.

As the pandemic lingers, Encompass Mobilizers continue to focus on mobilization and sending. Team members are pursuing new ways to utilize distance learning and digital tools to make connections. Pray that God blesses their efforts and sends more people to the field.

In Chile and Uruguay, the Charis Alliance's presence began through Latin American initiatives. While staying in Uruguay, Argentines José and Hilda Palacios connected with their neighbors, who became followers of Jesus and formed a church. Sensing God's desire for them to share the gospel beyond their national borders, Argentine church planters José and Susana Sepúlveda moved to Chile. Pray that Uruguayans and Chileans continue to share Christ. Pray that they collaborate effectively with Charis Alliance believers throughout Latin America.
