“The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.” John 2:5 This verse provides a powerful reminder that no matter what darkness we find ourselves in or what darkness we see in the world, God’s light shines and can not be overcome by darkness. We have been able to witness this “light in the darkness” during this season of COVID-19.

Amid the stay at home order and cut off from physically attending church and Awana, we struggled to know how best to stay connected with our Cubbies and parents. God did exceedingly abundantly more than we could have ever asked or imagined. Because we made weekly connections with the parents of our Cubbies through text or phone calls, I learned that one Cubbie parent’s mom had Stage 4 cancer. This family does not go to church, and we had limited connection during the in person club year. God’s light shined in the darkness of this young mom’s life. Our church body was able to walk the darkness with this family from diagnosis to burial. We uplifted this family in prayer and helped in other ways as well. Many of the family members want to come to church now that we are back in person. It is a privilege to be part of the church “being the church” as God intended.
