Thank you very much for the prayers for the Sumita family during Shinri's funeral. It was wonderful to see the spirit working in the hearts of family members as I shared the story of Shinri's journey of faith. Shinri's younger brother in particular, Kazuhiro came up to me after the message and was clearly moved. He said that six months ago when he talked with his brother, all he could sense was despair. Then, two months later (after Shinri came to faith), he could clearly sense a change in his brother, but said he couldn't figure out how it came about. After hearing at the funeral how Shinri had believed and received Jesus, and how his "outward flesh was decaying but his inward self was being renewed day by day" (2 Cor. 4:16), he said, "I totally understand now. I never realized how positive Christianity is." He had many more questions and says he wants to get together again. Other family members also came up to me with similar comments. Thank you again for praying for the Spirit's work; it was so evident! Please **pray** God uses Shinri's testimony to bring salvation to the whole Sumita family.

There's one more exciting thing coming up. We'll be heading out with some of our Youth Adult Fellowship leaders for a weekend spiritual retreat up in the mountains. We'll be seeking God around theme of being "Green Trees in a Drought" (Jer. 17:7-8). Please **pray** that God continues to bring transformation in the lives of these young leaders to make them more and more fruitful for His Kingdom. We look forward to the powerful work of the Spirit here as well!

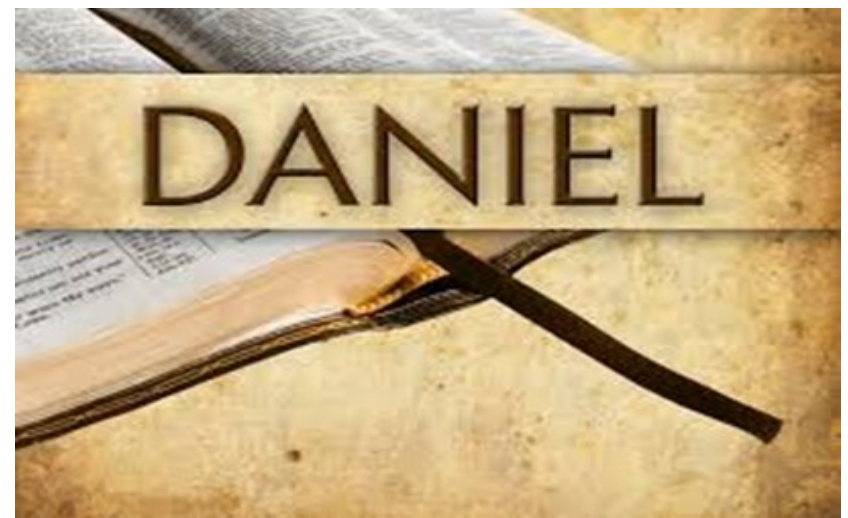
