Starting all over again: God has closed the door for us to return to the Island of Cotijuba and to continue as missionaries. We are now in the process of ending our ministry with Encompass World Partners and return to life as normal Americans.

The Lord has blessed us with a job for Wayne, located at the Wilmington, Ohio airport. The same town that our daughter Lydia lives in. Unfortunately, we currently live 75 miles north of Wilmington, so Wayne makes a 3 hour round trip daily commute.

Our desire is to buy a house near this location early next year, but we are still short funds to receive our resettlement allowance from Encompass World Partners.

The mission is permitting us to continue to receive funds through June of 2021 to pay for this resettlement allowance. The COVID situation has prevented us from raising these funds before the year ends. So please continue to send in your money and quarterly gifts through June 2021. The funds will assist in our effort to purchase a house and all the furnishings necessary to carve out a new life here in America.

Island Church Outreach: We left the church planting project in the hands of the local leaders in June, as COVID ravaged Brazil our little Island community the small church plant survived.

The police have stopped coming out to the Island and shutting down the business and our little church is once again out sharing the Gospel Message. Funds are tight and gas is very expensive in Brazil so our leadership team is taking a practical approach to getting around the island, petal power which is free.

They have put together an evangelism team that is traveling around the Island by bicycle to make visits to Farol Beach.




