Assist Church

Grace Church in Pataskala Ohio had over 40 volunteers decked out trunks of their vehicles in the church parking lot to host their very first Trunk-or-Treat event. Pastor Tim Wilmetti, says that they had anticipated approximately 200 people from the neighboring community to turn out to participate. But the church was delighted to see more than 800 guests on their campus, participating in some fall outdoor games, a hay ride and of course treats from the trunks.

Covid-19 has led to many restrictions for churches this year, but the Pataskala was deterred in providing this safe, socially distanced outreach opportunity for the people of their community that they hope to meet and introduce to Jesus. Grace Church is in the process of a 3-year revitalization partnership with Assist and is beginning to see great opportunity as a light for Jesus in their community.

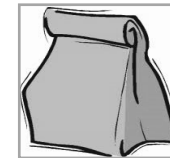
