## Encompass World Partners

**Ireland** is a tough place to reach with the gospel. Over the years, the Irish have been hurt by the Catholic church, and this history has contributed to the modern negative connotations surrounding religion. During their time here, **Roy and Holly** have learned that they need to take a different approach to discipleship and church planting than they would if they were living in the US, so in sharing the saving hope of Jesus, they have been prayerfully innovative. **Pray** that God will make Himself known to the people of Ireland. **Pray** that Roy and Holly will have overt opportunities to share Christ.

As a teacher, **Karen** was blessed to witness a class of **Cameroon Bible Institute wives** graduate in 2018 along with their husbands. The current class of 14 ladies is in their final year. Four of the women are reading well. Five are reading easy materials, even though four of them started coming to school only two years ago, not able to read at all. The remaining five look like they will not learn to read. **Pray** that all of these ladies continue growing to love and understand the Bible. **Pray** that those who can't read well will work at it diligently this year.

About every two seconds, **someone is forcibly displaced** from their home due to conflict or persecution (UNHCR, 2020). In **Germany**, God has called believers to care for the migrants who find themselves in a new country and in need of everything to rebuild their lives—housing, food, relief supplies, emotional healing, and hope in Jesus. Along with a local agency, Encompass staff enter relationships with these refugees and assess and meet their needs. **Pray** for the hurting as they encounter Christ's love for the first time.

Late last year, several severe hurricanes hit **Guatemala**. While the damage was extensive, the body of Christ came together to help the affected communities. Charis churches in Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Mexico, and Uruguay sent money to assist these believers, and Encompass' **Crisis Response Network** sent a financial gift as well. **Pray** for Guatemalans as they continue to rebuild after this devastation.
