Encompass World Partners

Late last year, several severe hurricanes hit Guatemala. While the damage was extensive, the body of Christ came together to help the affected communities. Charis churches in Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Mexico, and Uruguay sent money to assist these believers, and Encompass' Crisis Response Network sent a financial gift as well. **Pray** for Guatemalans as they continue to rebuild after this devastation. **Pray** for Charis churches in Central America as they aid their brothers and sisters in response to crises.

Encounter Columbus is a short missions training experience in this growing and increasingly diverse city in Ohio. Participants learn about other cultures and spend time with people from those cultures. The trip reveals God's heart for the nations and equips participants to share their faith with people from all backgrounds. It is an excellent opportunity for churches, youth groups, colleges, and individuals that reveals that there are people all around us who don't know the Lord—we don't have to cross the world to find them.

In 1990, Encompass sent workers to Porto, Portugal. These workers gathered new believers into small groups which later became a church. They also formed partnerships with other evangelicals. A Portuguese and American team then relocated south to the capital of Lisbon to establish spiritual communities. Like others in countries with Catholic heritages, many Portuguese question the church and its relevance to society. **Pray** that Portuguese believers demonstrate the gospel's power to transform and provide hope by how they live. **Pray** that they remain faithful to Christ and their commitment to be His witnesses.

Jean and Christine, originally from Lyon, France, decided to go with Encompass to North Africa. Before going, they visited the region several times to learn about the culture and people and realized just how many needs there are. God gave them favor, and they were able to serve in North Africa for a number of months before Covid.
